

Don't allow directory indexes by default

Options -Indexes

<IfModule mod_rewrite.c>

Remove the pesky index.php from URIs.

Technique adapted from example at

RewriteEngine on

Forbid browsing of the following directories/files

system/ - CodeIgniter directory

application/cache - Cache directory

externals/ - 3rd party stuff

.git - Any git files/folders*

RedirectMatch 403 ^/(system|application|cache|externals|\.git)\. *\$

Redirect all requests that don't go to an actual file or folder to

the CodeIgniter index.php

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-f

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-d

RewriteRule ^(\. *)\$ index.php/\$1 [L]

</IfModule>

<IfModule !mod_rewrite.c>

If we don't have mod_rewrite installed, all 404's

can be sent to index.php, and everything works as normal.
