RewriteCond %{REQUEST_URI} !.*\. (php) [NC]

*# If you are not using FileLayer, rewrite rules,
you can let the server decide when to 404, and
also get automatic addition of trailing slashes
to directories by uncommenting the following,
which will cause Plaster to only handle existing
files and directories*

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} -f [OR]

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} -d
