# Requesting the current directory or a non-existent index.html()
RewriteCond %(REQUEST_FILENAME) -d
RewriteCond %(REQUEST_FILENAME)index.html !-f
RewriteRule .* %(ENV:CWD)Sample.html?All [R,QSA,L]

# verify that we're only looking for files ending in html() that don't exist
RewriteCond %(REQUEST_FILENAME) !-f
