*# The following rule tells Apache that if the requested filename exists, simply serve it.*

RewriteCond %{REQUEST\_FILENAME} -s [OR]

RewriteCond %{REQUEST\_FILENAME} -l [OR]

RewriteCond %{REQUEST\_FILENAME} -d

RewriteRule ^.\*\$ - [NC,L]

*# The following rewrites all other queries to index.php. The condition ensures*

*# that if you are using Apache aliases to do mass virtual hosting,*

*# the base path will be prepended to allow proper resolution of*

*# the index.php file; it will work in non-aliased environments as well,*

*# providing a safe, one-size fits all solution.*
